Civil Society Forum Kashmir Organizes Training Camp on “Drug Abuse” in Kashmir Government Polytechnic College Srinagar on 02-Nov-2023.

Srinagar, Jammu and Kashmir – November 2, 2023 – The Civil Society Forum Kashmir (CSFK), in collaboration with the District Administration Srinagar, Crime Branch J&K Police, and Youth Development Rehabilitation Center, organized a one-day training camp on Drug Abuse for members of the Jammu and Kashmir Auqaf (J&K Auqaf) and faculty of the Kashmir Government Polytechnic College on November 2, 2023. 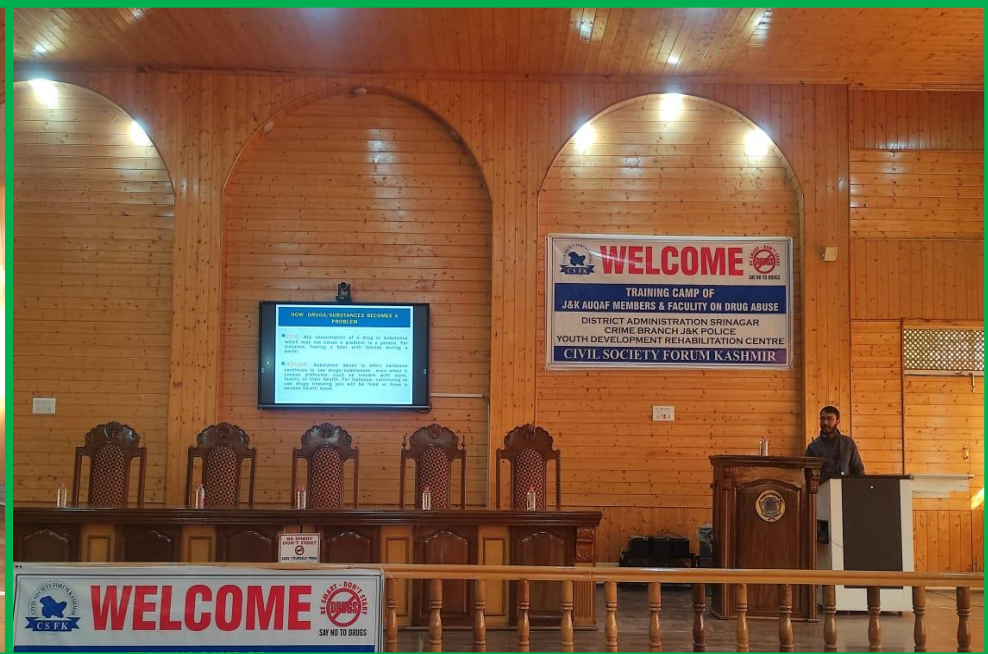
