As part of its ongoing Voter Awareness Programmes, Kashmir Government Polytechnic College Srinagar collaborated with the District Election Office Srinagar and organized a special voter registration drive on November 21, 2023 for the registration of eligible electors. This drive was in compliance with the District Election Officer Order No. 773/DEOS/SGR/2023/.639-67, dated 21-11-2023, and the JKDSD letter no. DSD/Poly/2066, dated 08-11-2023.

A team deputed by the Election Commission of India visited the institution to facilitate on-spot registration of eligible voters. The drive witnessed a surge in registrations, with many candidates completing the entire registration process while others progressed to the document upload stage. The team also provided comprehensive guidance on the procedures for enrolling new voters, updating election cards, and registering online at https://voters.eci.gov.in.The steps for registration on https://voters.eci.gov.in were explained to the participants. The event witnessed active participation from students and staff members, with many enrolling on the spot and others updating their election cards. This initiative underscores the institution's commitment to promoting civic engagement and fostering a culture of responsible voting among its student and staff communities.
