

Expert facilitators demonstrated step-by-step onboarding procedures, highlighting how sellers can leverage the open network to expand their reach, reduce dependency on intermediaries, and access a broader customer base seamlessly. The hands-on approach ensured that attendees left with actionable insights to integrate ONDC into their business operations immediately.

Feedback from the sellers was overwhelmingly positive, with many expressing appreciation for the clarity and relevance of the information shared. "This platform is a game-changer for small sellers like us in Kashmir. The guidance today has demystified digital commerce, and we're excited to get started," shared one participant during the Q&A segment.

In addition to the core program, Sh. Shahzad Alam, IAS, conducted an extensive tour of the KGP Srinagar campus. He visited several departments, interacted with faculty members, and commended the institution's role in skill development and innovation.
