Successful conduct of JKPSC Examination for the post of Lecturer-I in various Disciplines.



The highly anticipated inter-departmental cricket match was successfully concluded in the institution between the students of Electrical Engineering and Computer Engineering.


The Computer Department secured a convincing victory over the Electrical Department in a spirited contest. The match showcased excellent sportsmanship and rivalry among the students.





➤ KGP Srinagar Successfully Submits All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) Data.


