Awareness and Training Session on "Renewable Energy" Held at Kashmir Government Polytechnic College Srinagar.

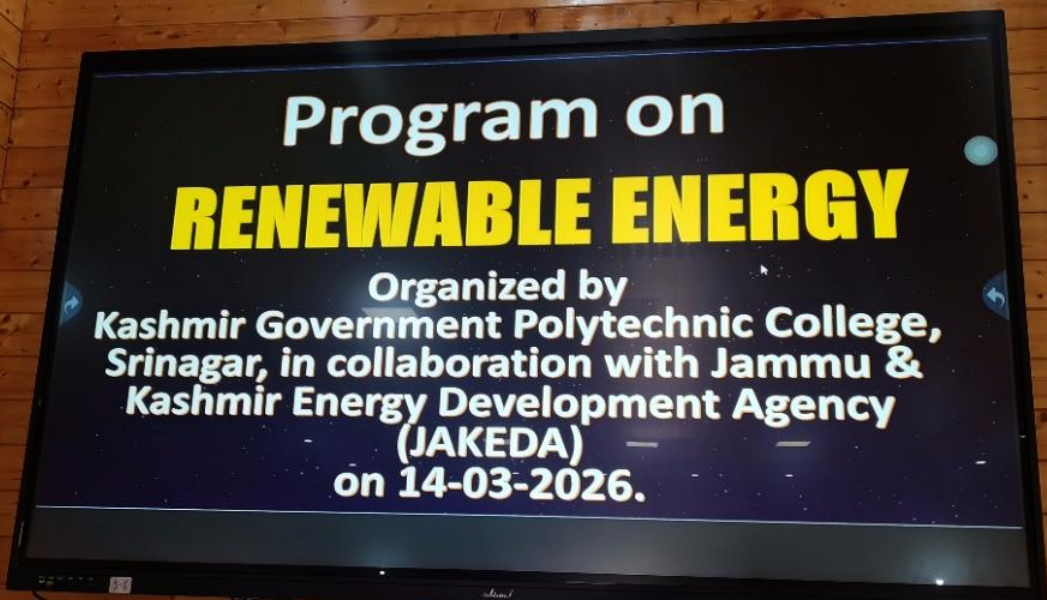

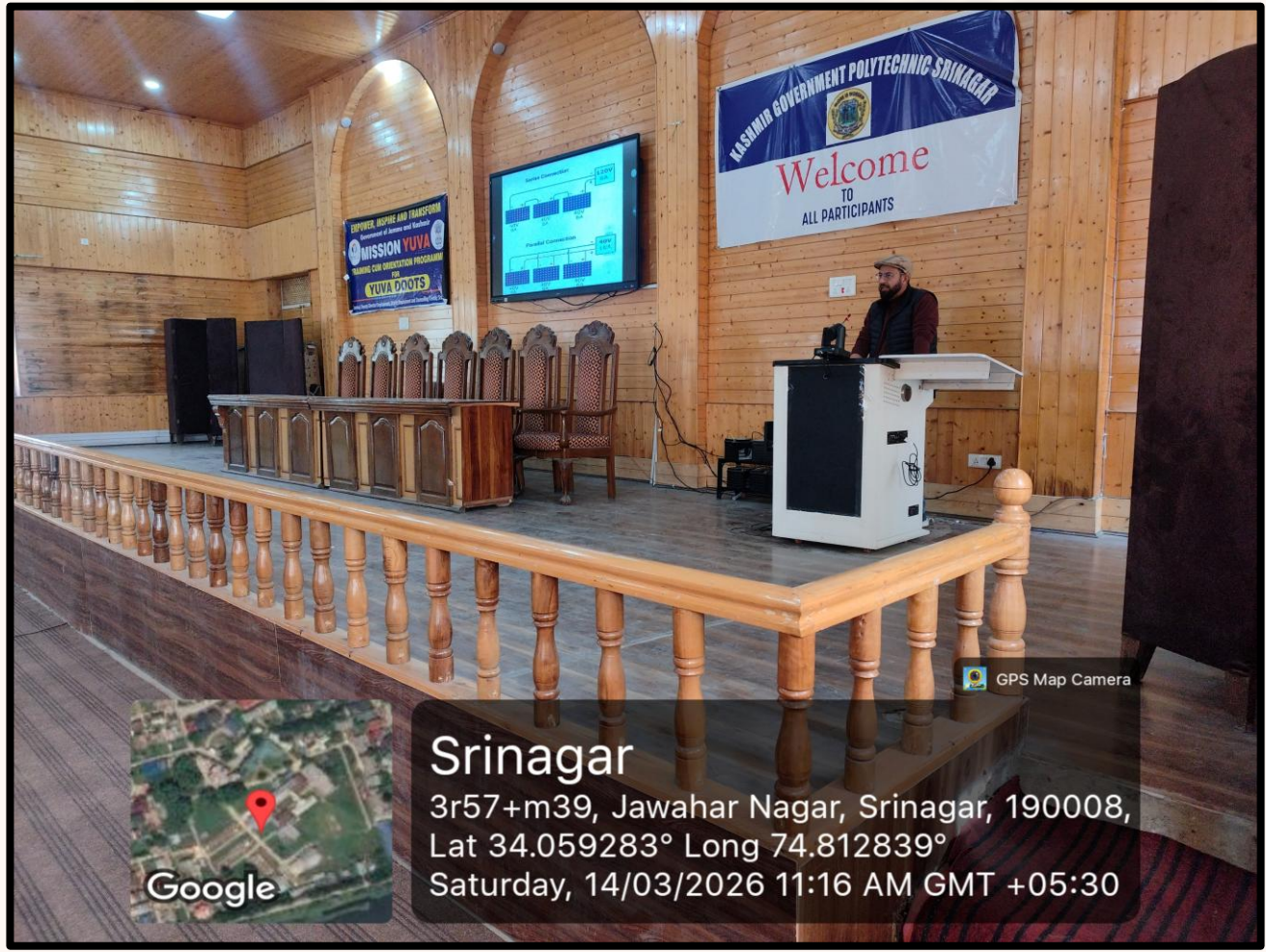
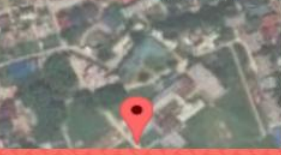
