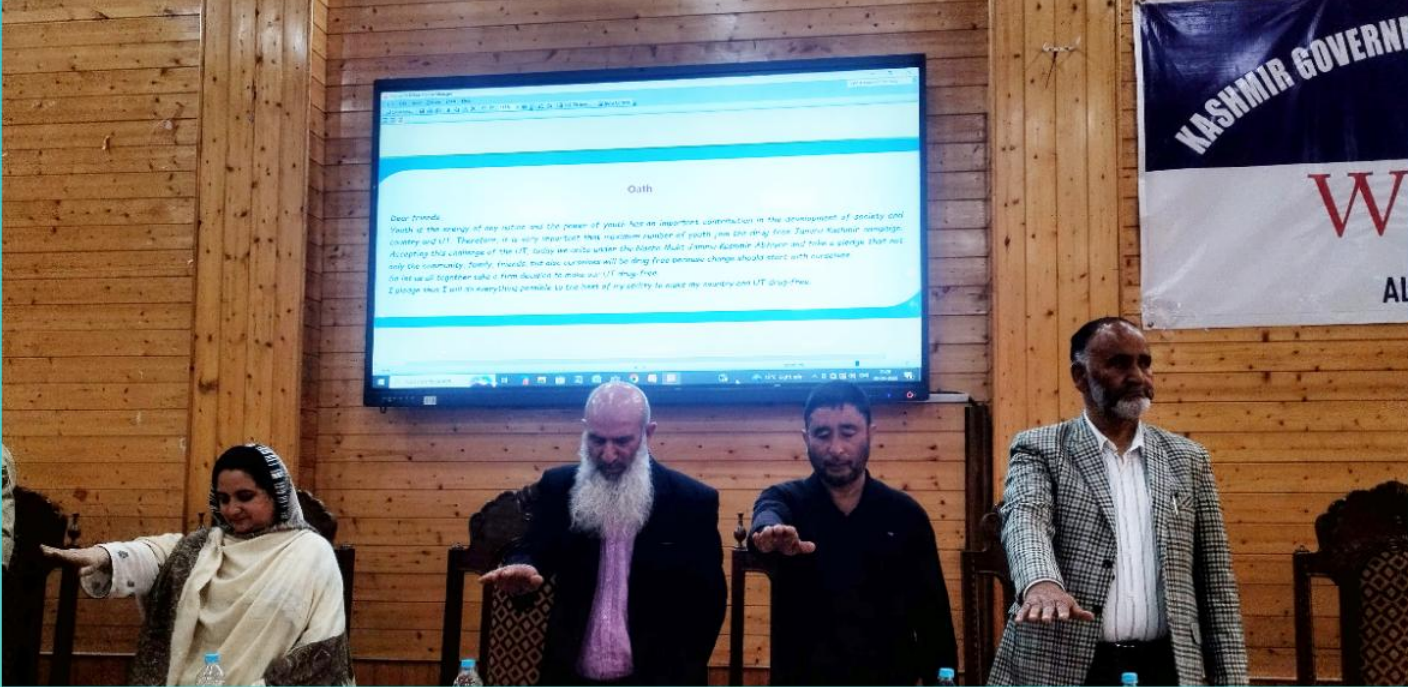














Oath
